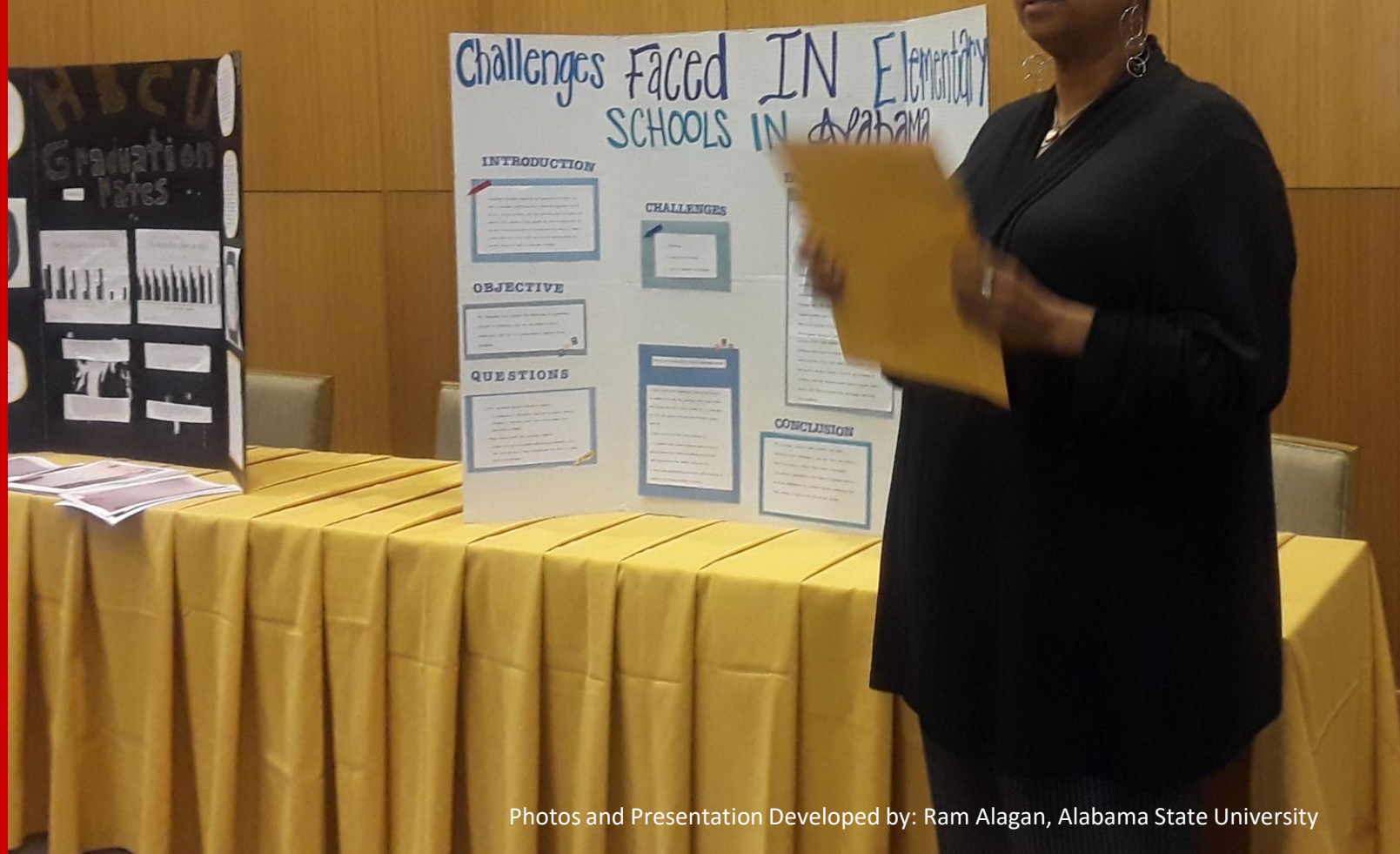




























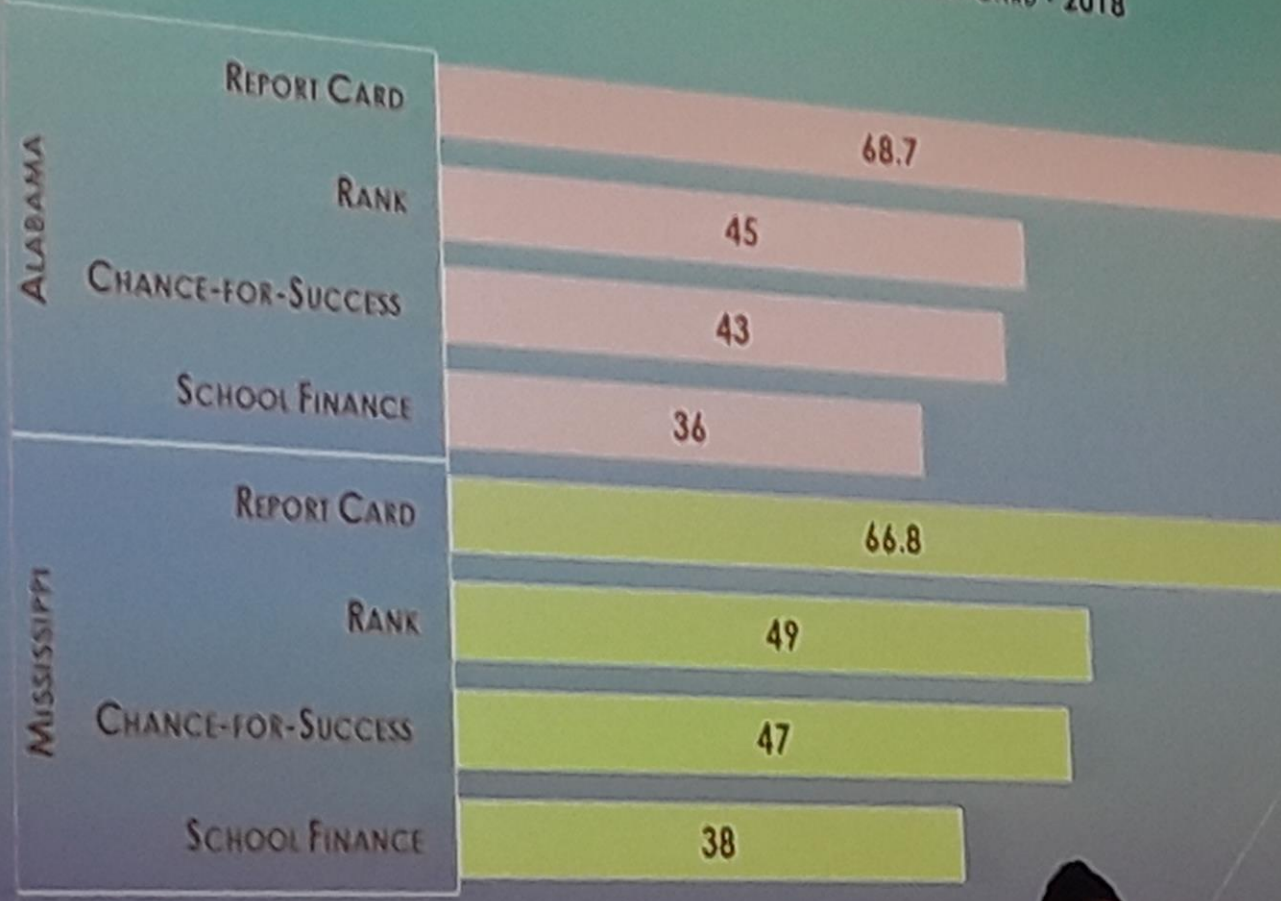








FIGURE 1. ALABAMA AND MISSISSIPPI EDUCATION REPORT CARD - 2018
